## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

Q: What are liquid fertilizers?

A: Generally, liquid fertilizers are highly concentrated formulations that contain readily available nutrients that bolster soil microorganisms and improve the soil structure. Liquid fertilizers provide nutrients not generally available in N-P-K.

Q: How often should I fertilize my pastures?

A: Pastures should be fertilized at least once per year

Q: What is the best type of fertilizer – liquid or granular?

A: Both are good – it is a matter of personal preference. Liquid fertilizer is economical and cost effective though, and can be mixed with commonly used pesticides. Liquid fertilizer can be formulated more and customized with TE.( Trace Elements ) Like 10.5.5.3.3 or 5.16.30.5.5.4

Q: What do those numbers stand for?

A: The first number is the percentage of nitrogen – which is good for the leaves. The second number is the percentage of phosphorus – which is good for the stems. The third number is potash – which is good for the root system.

Q: What type of fertilizer works faster?

A: Liquid will give you quicker results, as it is active as it is being dispensed. Granular needs to be watered in, and since most pastures are not irrigated, it will be activated when it rains.

Q: What is the best way to control weeds in my pasture?

A: Having a good stand of grass, frequent mowing and keeping fencelines sprayed for weeds. This will keep weeds from growing large enough to release seeds. If the weeds are not able to reproduce, the grass growth will eventually choke them out.
